Authentication & Billing

While some locations may choose not to charge their visitors for Internet access, others may choose to allow their guests to utilise one of four different methods:

Access by PIN

A location can have Griffin generate PINs to be sold to visitors. On generation, the duration of the PIN can be specified together with the bandwidth that the visitor may not exceed.

Access by Room/Password

Griffin can interface with a property's management system by emulating any given PBX system, i.e. the transactions that are sent from and received by Griffin are identical to those sent and received by any specific PBX system. The System Administrator has the ability to specify which PBX system Griffin should emulate, providing a seamless billing method identical to how a property's telephone system interfaces with their other systems.

Alternatively, Room/Password combinations can be 'manually' assigned by the property's management.

Access by Username/Password

Usernames and Passwords can be authenticated against information on RADIUS servers, including Flexsys' own. This allows guests with internet access accounts and members of hotel chain reward systems to sign in directly without any involvement from the property's staff.

Access on provision of credit card information

Credit card details are accepted from the visitor and passed to one of the world's largest and most reputable authorisation services. Payment approval, or rejection, is immediate.
